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OUR PROGRAM

Have your child enjoy a full immersion experience!

Children will develop their skills and broaden their horizons, make new friends and be exposed to French! Embark on An eight week journey into French language and culture: Language Classes, Arts and Crafts, Song, Dance and Music, Games, Sports, Cooking and Field Trips... and much more, for children ages 6 to 11. All levels of French are welcome.

ACTIVITIES IN FRENCH

At least once a week, children will go on a field trip to the beach, museums or other fun places to visit. We will make use of the brand new Expo light-rail line that runs between Downtown Los Angeles and Santa Monica.

Activities are age-appropriate and tailored to the language level of the children. We offer language instruction for everyone from the beginner to the bilingual student.

A comprehensive approach to Language Acquisition!

Through oral and written comprehension as well as speaking and writing exercises, students acquire the linguistic tools they will need to effectively communicate in a variety of contexts. The program is divided up in three levels, which target the language objectives defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages at levels A1, A2, B1 and B2. Students will learn to form sentence structures based on level-specific grammar and vocabulary, all while discovering Francophone culture through French literature, artistic movements, distinctive regional traditions and idiomatic expressions. Interactive class activities and a task-based approach place students at the center of the learning process and effectively take them from oral and written comprehension to speaking and writing. Open to all levels of French.

A summer of adventures in French!

Expanding beyond the traditional classroom setting, students explore French through a variety of disciplines – all in immersion. Engaging thematic workshops enable them to understand and create their own work in French. Beginner to advanced students experience French culture through workshops in cooking at French restaurants, studio art, theater, fashion, sports and field trips to museums and galleries. They will meet French artists, learn the basics of French cuisine, discover artistic and architectural movements and create a web journal to remember their trips and workshops!
